The Delaware Valley Stroke Council (**DVSC**), The Stroke Authority in the region, will ring the opening bell on Tuesday, May 6 to kick off Stroke Alert Day.

Nurses from Albert Einstein Medical Center will be on the trading floor to do blood pressure screenings for PHLX employees and traders from 8:30 a.m. until 10:00 a.m.

Glenn “Hurricane” Schwartz , NBC 10’s chief meteorologist, is teaming up with the DVSC and the PHLX to get lifesaving messages of stroke prevention and stroke warning signs to the public.
