SUBJECT: EMERGENCY ELECTRICAL SHUTDOWN

**\*\*\*\*IMPORTANT NOTICE\*\*\*\***

Building management notified us that the emergency testing and checking of the transfer gear in use in the building that was performed on Saturday, August 25, 2007 was unsuccessful.

Therefore, building management has just informed us that they will perform **emergency testing and checking of the transfer gear again, on Friday, August 31, 2007, beginning at 9:00 PM.**

As before, the building will experience the same effects as a normal PECO outage as the lights and power will be affected for a very short time while the transfer takes effect. Should the transfer not take effect as anticipated, the building will be immediately restored to normal operating conditions. The building expects the testing portion of this process to take no more than 15 minutes.

**The Exchange will bring the emergency generator online for the duration of this event.**

**Member Firms equipment will be affected, it is very important that Member Firms take whatever measures necessary (such as powering down all computers) to safeguard their computer equipment and systems.**

Financial Automation will be responsible for all Exchange equipment. Therefore, **there is no need to power down Exchange equipment.**
