RE: WITHDRAWAL OF APPROVAL OF CERTAIN
UNDERLYING SECURITIES AS OPTION CLASSES

Pursuant to the Exchange Rule 1010, The Philadelphia Stock Exchange, Inc. (Exchange) has determined that the common stock of ARAMARK Corporation (RMK), Conor Medsystems, Inc. (CONR), Equity Properties Trust (EOP), Grupo TMM SA (TMM), Innovex, Inc. (INVX), Kanbay International, Inc. (KBAY), Navistar International Corporation (NAV), Oregon Steel Mills, Inc. (OS), Per-Se Technologies Inc. (PSTI), Reckson Associates Realty Corp (RA), Rita Medical Systems, Inc. (RITA), Solexa, Inc. (SLXA), The Yankee Candle Company (YCC), Verint Systems, Inc. (VRNT), Veritas DGC, Inc. (VTS), and Wireless Facilities Inc. (WFII), no longer meet the current requirements necessary to maintain approval as securities underlying listed options.

Therefore, the Exchange will not open any additional (RMK), (CONR), (EOP), (TMM), (INVX), (KBAY), (NAV), (OS), (PSTI), (RA), (RITA), (SLXA), (YCC), (VRNT), (VTS), and (WFII) option series.

Further, the Exchange requests that member organizations advise their customers of this announcement before entering option orders for customer accounts in the above noted issues.
