Subject: Symbol Technologies, Inc. (SBL) MERGER EFFECTIVE

On Tuesday, January 9, 2007, the shareholders of Symbol Technologies, Inc. (SBL) voted to approve the proposed merger with Motorola, Inc. (MOT). Pursuant to the merger terms each SBL share will be converted into the right to receive \$15.00 cash. **The merger became effective on Tuesday, January 9, 2007.**

Pursuant to Options Clearing Corporation (OCC) By-Laws, all outstanding SBL options will be adjusted as follows:

EFFECTIVE DATE: Wednesday, January 10, 2007
NEW DELIVERABLE: \$1,500.00 cash per contract (\$15.00 x 100)

Existing open interest in all SBL options will remain until options are either exercised or expire. Since they are American style options, they are exercisable at the option of the holder.
