RE: WITHDRAWAL OF APPROVAL OF CERTAIN
UNDERLYING SECURITIES AS OPTION CLASSES

Pursuant to the Exchange Rule 1010, The Philadelphia Stock Exchange, Inc. (Exchange) has determined that the common stock of Aleris International, Inc. (ARS), American Italian Pasta Company (AITP), Aztar Corporation (AZR), BellSouth Corporation (BLS), Broadwing Corporation (BWNG), Connetics Corp. (CNCT), Gold Kist, Inc. (GKIS), Escala Group, Inc. (ESCL), Global Signal, Inc (GSL), Inco Limited (INCLF), Metrlogic Instruments, Inc (MTLG), PortalPlayer, Inc. (PLAY), Power Integrations (POWI), Symbol Technologies (SBL), and Talk America Holdings, Inc. (TALK), no longer meet the current requirements necessary to maintain approval as securities underlying listed options.

Therefore, the Exchange will not open any additional (ARS), (AITP), (AZR), (BLS), (BWNG), (CNCT), (ESCL), (GSL), (GKIS), (INCLF), (MTLG), (PLAY), (POWI), (SBL), and (TALK) option series.

Further, the Exchange requests that member organizations advise their customers of this announcement before entering option orders for customer accounts in the above noted issues.
